

BID Landscaping Policy

The Business Improvement District may install plantings on private property with the following guidelines:

- 1. So as to contribute to the overall aesthetic of Downtown, the location must be within the BID, in the public right of way and be highly visible.
- 2. Our staff horticulturist must design the landscape plan, including the selection and number of plants.
- 3. The BID will purchase plants and planting materials. The property owner will be charged for the plants and materials at cost, plus a small surcharge for fuel and other expenses.
- 4. BID employees will install the planting.
- 5. The property owner will be responsible for watering the bed after installation. If the property owner fails to water or maintain the beds, the BID reserves the right to withdraw from the arrangement.
