Re: Sidewalk Alcohol Sales during 1065 Music Festival

Dear Business Owner:

The City of Mobile is excited about the upcoming 1065 Music Festival being held in Downtown Mobile from September 30 through October 2, 2016. The City is extending to the licensees within the Entertainment District, a one-time limited use agreement. This agreement is between each licensee and the City and will allow licensees to extend their sales and service area to include the area in front of, and immediately adjacent to, their licensed premises. This extended space must be reasonable and permit the normal flow of pedestrian traffic for use of the sidewalk. This does not include the street or any area not mentioned above.

This extended sales and service area covering the sidewalk will be treated by ABC Board as each retailer's licensed premises (patio) for purposes of selling and serving alcohol during this event. Each retailer serving alcohol in such area will be responsible to maintain such area in accordance with law, and all alcohol sold in such area will be served in its original container.

This is a one-time usage agreement, and as such the ABC Board has agreed to recognize this as an extension of your licensed premises for this year's 1065 Music Festival only. In the future, any use of the city sidewalks for sales, service, patio usage, or any other use by a licensee will require an individual usage agreement with the City and/or comply with the DDD Ordinance. This agreement will have to set out the exact parameters of the extended area. This will also have to be submitted to the ABC Board and added to your licensed premises.

We appreciate your attention to the contents of this letter, and look forward to the success of 1065!
