## Why This Matters

For every \$1 invested in state historic tax credits, the program has generated nearly \$12 in statewide economic output — a return of almost 12-to-1. This is a proven economic tool that converts modest state investment into private development, jobs, and tax revenue. These buildings return to productive use which strengthens downtowns, supports small towns, and drives smart growth for Alabama.


